



Virtual Games – What's In Your Home?

Description

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Help your students learn more about each other in this engaging activity. Students will learn about the other students by taking a sneak peek into their homes.

Supplies

No supplies needed

How to Play

- 1. This activity works best on a virtual platform where students can see each other, like Zoom.
- 2. Tell your students that there will be multiple rounds played and they will earn points based on what they can find in their homes.
- 3. Announce each round and the possible points they can earn for that round.
- 4. Set a time limit for students to return with the item and keep track of points throughout the different rounds.
- 5. Item Search Examples
 - Pen 1 point
 - Crayon 1 point
 - Marker 1 point
 - ∘ Key 2 points
 - ∘ Remote 2 points
 - Pillow 2 points
 - ∘ Ruler 2 points
 - ∘ Board game 5 points
 - ∘ Favorite toy 5 points



- ∘ Ball 5 points
- Favorite shoe 5 points
- Favorite picture 5 points
- Favorite food 5 points

Activity Prompts for Reflection

- What is something new you learned about someone else during this activity?
- What is one thing you had in common with someone else during this activity?
- Did someone have a different opinion than you? If so, what was it?

Other Ways to Play

- Give students a certain number of items to find at a time and see which student finds them first. Example: find a pen, ruler, and marker
- Instead of naming the item students must find, describe the item and have students try to guess what the item is, find it, and be the first back to the camera.
