

Seek and Find

Description

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Students listen carefully to find various objects in the space.

Supplies

• No supplies needed

How to Play

- 1. Explain that today's activity is all about listening carefully and finding different items.
- 2. Explain that in each round a category will be announced and students must search for something that fits the category.
- 3. The first student to return with an item that fits that category gets a point.
- 4. The student with the most points at the end wins. Multiple rounds can be played until time is up.
- 5. The list of items will depend on the space, but an example list is provided below.
- 6. Example Items:
 - Something that starts with the letter A
 - Something that you can write with
 - Something that bounces
 - Something smaller than your hand
 - Something that makes you feel happy
 - $\circ\,$ Something with an animal on it
 - Something that makes noise
 - Something that moves around a lot
 - Something the same size as your foot

Activity Prompts for Reflection

- What was frustrating about this activity?
- What helped you be successful during this activity?
- What helped you to stay focused during this activity?
- What were you in control of during this activity?

Other Ways to Play

- Have the first student to find an item come up with the category for the next search.
- If there is a large group of students, award points to the first and second students to come back with an item for that category.
- If not in a classroom setting, make sure to set boundaries for the search area.
