



Don't Drop the Eggs

Description

Description

Group works together to untangle themselves and keep the "eggs" safe.

Supplies

• 4 small objects like candies, erasers, pen caps

How to Play

- 1. Pass out the "eggs" to four students in the group.
- 2. Tell the group that the goal of this game is to make sure the "eggs" stay safe as the group makes and untangles themselves in a human knot.
- 3. Have students form the knot by standing in a circle. Students then reach out one hand and grab the hand of another student standing opposite them. They must then reach out their other hand and grab the hand of a different student. No one should be holding hands with someone standing right next to them.
- 4. Remind students who have an "egg" to make sure to keep their "egg" safe between their hand and the other person's hand.
- 5. Allow the students to start to untangle, reminding them that their hands must stay connected.
- 6. Explain that if an "egg" drops, the group must start over by making a new knot and trying to get untangled again.

Activity Prompts for Reflection

- What did you do to make sure you used kind words during this activity?
- What made it difficult to work together during this activity?



- What is something you would do differently if we played this activity again?
- Did anyone have a strength that they were able to use during this activity?

Other Ways to Play

- If untangling the knot is too difficult for younger students have them stand in a circle and pass the egg around the circle in different ways, trying to keep it from falling. Examples: pass it around the circle using only one finger, with your eyes closed, behind your back, etc.
- Make this activity more challenging by allowing students to form a strategy for how they want to approach this challenge before hand. Then, once it is time to untangle, the group must remain silent.

Additional Notes

- Use the SEL Activity Prompts to tie other SEL competencies to this activity.
- If your group is larger than 12 students divide them into smaller groups and have them compete against each other to get untangled the fastest.
