



Strengths and Weaknesses BINGO

Description

Description

Students reflect on their strengths and weaknesses and learn more about others in this BINGO activity.

Supplies

- SEL Activity Strengths and Weaknesses BINGO Cards for each student
- Markers/ crayons

How to Play

- 1. Give each student a BINGO card and a writing utensil.
- 2. Provide time for students to read through each BINGO square and decide if it is a strength or a weakness. Students write S for strength or W for weakness inside each box.
- 3. Once all students are done, have students move around talking with other students, finding students who have the same strength or weaknesses.
- 4. Once they find a student with the same strength or weakness they sign that BINGO square.
- 5. This continues until a student has 5 BINGO squares with signatures in a row (horizontally, diagonally, or vertically), and they yell out BINGO!

Activity Prompts for Reflection

- What is something new you learned about someone else today?
- What is a strength you shared that you'd like to show us?
- What is one weakness that you are currently working on?
- What is a strength that you have that wasn't on your BINGO card?



Other Ways to Play

- If there is additional time, continue playing having students try to get signatures in every BINGO square.
- Make it more challenging by making students get a different student's signature in each box.
- Edit the BINGO squares to make them more relatable for your students.
